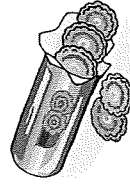
Congregational Meeting at the end of the church service :

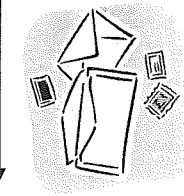

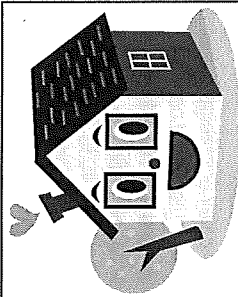
