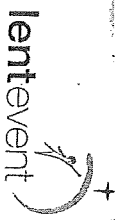
David will be in leave for 4 weeks returning to work on May 3rd then moving house during that week

 of Trade Union movement**

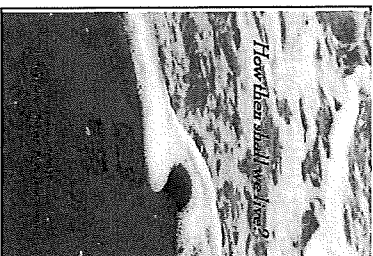
The ongoing work of the museum group has begun some exciting work on  
 the history of George Loveless—Methodist lay preacher—convict who, with  
 his colleagues, was pardoned and returned to London. We have just located  
 at Unions Tasmania the commemoration plaque noting his contribution and  
 association with Wesley and the Trades Hall. As part of building relations  
 with the Methodist church in the UK we are in touch with the Tolpuddle  
 Methodist church and its museum. David and Chris have been invited to visit  
 Tolpuddle and will take our greetings and hopefully a bottle of wine from the  
 Tolpuddle vineyard in Richmond.
